## Who are we?

We are a group of people from various walks of life who share a love of gardening, floral design, and nature.

Our objective is to promote gardening and floral design among ourselves and throughout the community. We emphasize respect for the natural environment and encourage pollinator gardens.

One ongoing project is Flowers of Hope, a joint project of our garden club, Kroger stores, and the Salvation Army. We use fresh flowers donated weekly by Kroger to create lovely flower arrangements that we distribute to various worthy places around Johnson City to spread beauty and hope.

## What do we do?

- **Monthly meetings**, which include an informative program on gardening, nature, or floral design, a club business meeting, and a display of horticulture specimens and floral designs.
- **Field trips** to various nearby places related to gardening and nature.
- Occasional **workshops** on floral design or gardening topics.
- **Community service** projects such as creating gardens at Carver Park Community Garden, the children's garden at Johnson City Public Library, and Flowers of Hope.
- **Fellowship** events including a picnic, a luncheon, and a holiday party.
- Biennial **Garden Tour** of local gardens.
- Biennial **Flower Show** open to the public.
- **Plant Sale** fundraisers.



## When and where do we meet?

May through September we meet on the first Thursday of each month at 5:30 pm. October through April we meet on the first Wednesday of each month at 10 am.

Most monthly meetings take place at Wesley Memorial United Methodist Church, which is located at 225 Princeton Rd. in Johnson City.

Three times a year we have special meetings that take place at other nearby locations.
